The Coordinated Service Planning model is intended to improve the service experience and outcomes for children and youth with multiple complex special needs and their families. These young people may be experiencing challenges related to multiple areas including physical, communication, intellectual, emotional, social, and/or behavioural development. The Service Planning Coordinator connects young people and their families to the required services and supports which may include services delivered in other sectors, various community-based services, and the services of multidiscipline professionals. The Coordinator is responsible for developing, implementing and monitoring a single Coordinated Service Plan with each young person and their family, in response to the individual's goals, strengths and needs.

The ideal candidate will have a minimum of 5 years experience working in children's developmental and children's mental health services, post secondary education in social services, along with the following:

- Demonstrated ability to work collaboratively with individuals, families, and multidisciplinary teams

- Ability to work in an environment of change
- Proven ability to work both independently and collaboratively
